DANIEL BANKS



Daniel Banks is a director, deviser, dance dramaturg, and dialogue facilitator. He has directed at National Theatre of Uganda; Belarussian National Drama Theatre; Market Theatre Lab, South Africa; Playhouse Square, Cleveland; HERE Arts Center, NY; Bay Area Playwrights Festival; NYC and DC Hip Hop Theatre Festivals; & Oval House, Teatro Technis, and with Kompany Malakhi, London. He worked as movement director/choreographer at Shakespeare in the Park, Theatre for a New Audience, Maurice Sendak's *The Night Kitchen*, Singapore Rep, and La Monnaie. He is Associate Director of Theatre Without Borders, on the national cabinet of US Department of Arts and Culture, on The Drama League's Directors Council, the 2020 recipient of TCG's Alan Schneider Director Award, and a recent recipient of Harvardwood Heroes award for his work co-instigating the project to transform 1012 N. Main Street, Fort Worth's former KKK Auditorium, into a center and museum for art and community healing.

ADAM W. MCKINNEY



Adam W. McKinney is a former member of Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater, Béjart Ballet Lausanne, Alonzo King LINES Ballet, Cedar Lake Contemporary Ballet, and Milwaukee Ballet Company. He served as a U.S. Embassy Culture Connect Envoy to South Africa through the U.S. State Department to engage communities through dance. Other select awards include New York University's President's Service Award for dance work with populations who struggle with heroin addiction, a Jerome Foundation Emerging Choreographers grant, a National Artist Teacher Fellowship for DNAWORKS's "The Borders Project," and a School of American Ballet National Teacher Fellowship. He is

the Co-Founder and Past President of Tarrant County Coalition for Peace and Justice, an organization created to honor victims of oppression and reflect more accurately on the history of racial terror violence in Tarrant County, Texas. Named one of the most influential African Americans in Milwaukee, WI by St. Vincent DePaul, McKinney holds a B.F.A. in Dance Performance from Butler University and an M.A. in Dance Studies with concentrations in Race and Trauma theories from NYU-Gallatin. Adam is Co-Founder of DNAWORKS, an arts and service organization dedicated to dialogue and healing through the arts, engaging topics of representation, identity, and heritage. McKinney is the Artistic Director of Pittsburgh Ballet Theatre.

Laura Bustillos Jáquez is a documentary filmmaker and photographer from the border of Mexico and the United States. As a Transnational Woman of Color, she focuses on telling stories about immigration and social reconstruction Laura graduated with a BA in Visual Journalism and a special recognition from Brooks Institute in Ventura, California. She then obtained a David Lynch MA in Film at Maharishi University in 2015. She is an alumna of The Laundromat Project in NYC, was 2019's Distinguished Global Speaker on Immigration, Humanity, and Empowerment at Towson University in Baltimore, Maryland, participated in Creative lecturer of "Decolonizing our Identities" at the Universidad Autónoma de Ciudad Juarez as well as at Institut Supérieur des Métiers de l'Audiovisuel in Cotonou, Benin, among other of La Bú Productions and is currently based in New York City and Ciudad Juarez-El Paso (Mexico-U.S. Border).
